

English (Including Homework)

Homework will be given out Monday and will need to be handed in by the following Thursday. (Every two weeks)

Spellings, punctuation and grammar taught each week.
Guided reading sessions – 3/4 sessions a week.

Create a fact file or leaflet about the importance of looking after your teeth. Children write explanations about tooth decay. They write a piece of fantasy narrative imagining they are food travelling through the digestive system.

Children to create character profiles on King Arthur and Alfred the Great. Retell the legend of King Arthur.
Children to write a historical narrative, imagining they are a Viking child living in Britain during the Dark Ages.

- Reading and writing numbers to 2 decimal places.
- Ordering numbers and comparing numbers beyond 1000 using human time line.
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000.

Addition and Subtraction

- Calculate addition and subtraction calculations with numbers up to 4 digits.
- Solve addition and subtraction two-step problems.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts.
