
Dear Parent/carer,

50th Anniversary

The school building is 50 years old this year and we are celebrating this milestone tomorrow. The children have decided they want a 60's day with lots of fab music hairstyles and flares! Homework in KS2

This year we have decided to take a new approach to homework. We want to put the emphasis onto key skills as the most effective way of supporting learning at home.

Reading: younger and less confident readers should practice reading every night with an adult. Parents should listen to and question more confident readers at least twice a week.

Tables: J2Blast on Hwb every week to practice their target tables.

Spelling: J2Blast spelling every week to practice at their level and given spellings for weekly tests.

Presentation: Once a term children prepare a presentation on an aspect of the topic. This will be completed to be presented to the class following half term. The teachers will outline the new system to the children this week.

Daily Mile

As part of our emphasis on health and well-being we are relaunching the daily mile for the school. Each class will walk laps of the field for 10-15 minutes every morning before registration. We hope this will have really positive effects on the health and learning aptitudes of the children.

Parent Workshops

Following the success of the workshops run last term the Swansea Family Partnership are coming back to offer another programme for us. Laura Collins will be running drop in sessions from Tuesday 24th until half term. These are open for any parent who wants to come and get some advice or draw on her expertise. She will also run the STEPS programme after half term, starting on Tuesday November 5th.

Laura Collins is the tutor and says the STEPS programme based around applied-self-image psychology. It is a course designed around human motivation and behaviour. The STEPS programme helps to translate the scientific jargon into easily understood language.

It helps provide opportunities for individuals to realise their full potential.

Intelligent, inquisitive, incredible, inventive.


Outstanding opportunities, open, optimistic learners overcoming challenges
