Dear pupils, parents and families,

Welcome back! I hope that you have all have a wonderful summer break and are ready for the year ahead!



#### What will be learning about?

In English we will be focussing on Phonological Awareness, Read Write Inc phonics and Pie Corbett to develop the children's narrative skills. This term we will be incorporating basic language skills during Literacy time to account for the speech and language programmes.

In maths we will be looking at place value initially and revisiting basic skills in areas such as money, shape, time etc. As the term progresses we will challenge these areas of learning.

Our topic this term is Road Trip USA. We will be exploring all aspects of the USA and consider the question 'Would you recommend a trip in the USA?'

### Speech and Language



At present due to continued restrictions our speech therapist will visiting school on a limited basis for face to face therapy. Children will receive teletherapy and we will continue their programmes within class and children will be withdrawn for 1:1 intervention in the afternoons/

Dos. Awyr/Lleuad and Ynys are now one bubble. This allows pupils to mix freely at breaktime. This will also allow us some flexibility and increased opportunities for mainstream integration. This will hopefully build as the term progresses.
