What will be learning about?

In English we will be focussing on Phonological Awareness, Read Write Inc phonics and Pie Corbett to develop the children's narrative skills. This term we will be incorporating basic language skills during Literacy time to account for the speech and language programmes.

In maths we will be looking number (addition/subtraction/ordinal number), shape (2d and 3d) and the calendar. As the term progresses we will challenge these areas of learning.

We are continuing this term with the topic Road Trip USA. We will be exploring famous people and the history of the USA (Native American). Alongside this will be mini topics on The Gunpowder Plot, Remembrance Day, Christmas etc.

Speech and Language

At present we are still restricted with face to face sessions however Miss Frances (SLT) has booked in sessions to update assessments and monitor progress. Programmes will continue to be delivered within the class and individual programmes timetabled for the Cwtch.

Pupils to wear PE clothes in on a Friday.

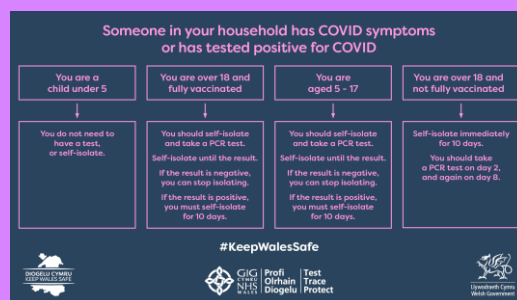
Home school folders to be returned everyday. This will be our main point of contact. Please feel free to write in this book and remember to check it every evening for messages.
