



Personalised Assessment for Numeracy (Procedural)

As with all other schools last year, our pupils took the online personalised assessment for *Numeracy (Procedural)*. You will have received or viewed a report containing the age-standardised score in your child's most recent assessment. Personalised assessments provide us with information on a child's skills, allowing our teachers to offer tailored support to help your child's progress. A minor issue was identified in the calculations for the age-standardised scores, so Welsh Government has now made changes to correct this. As a result, there may be a slight adjustment in your child's score. The age-standardised score is just one piece of information that we have on your child's skills, and movement of a few points will not affect our teaching and learning plans for your child. If you wish to discuss your child's report, please do get in touch with us.

Any changes in individual scores will be shared with parents when they are released by Welsh Government. Schools have been informed that this will not be for 4 weeks.

End of school day – Thank you for your support with the trial of afternoon dismissal from the playground side of the school.
