Our team of trained staff assist with:

- Understanding Additional Learning Needs (ALN)
- Providing impartial, clear and accurate local information, advice and support
- Listening to families talk things through
- Providing information on a wide range of support services
- Practical support dealing with letters, forms and understanding professional reports
- Supporting families to make informed decisions about school and other educational placements, and provision from health, education, social services and other agencies
- Supporting families to work in partnership with and keeping good working relationships with professionals
- Assisting in developing good working practice between schools and parents/carers
- Supporting families to have a voice
- Training for parents, carers and professionals

- Advice on rights and responsibilities
- Understanding a child's Individual Educational Plan (IEP)
- School Action & School Action Plus (SA/SA+)

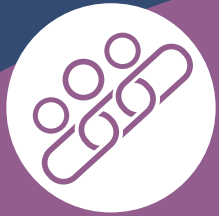
