

Maths and Numeracy. *Maths.*

Active Learn Abacus Scheme - place value, multiplication and division, addition and subtraction, fractions and decimals.

Rich task activity - planning a family holiday around the world. Focusing on transferring and applying learnt literacy and numeracy skills.

Numeracy activities based on population, currency, size, time, distance and temperature.

Daily routine - presenting data using charts and graphs

Sorting, comparing and converting data on rivers and mountains around the world.

Dinasfawr project - applying and transferring learnt numeracy skills.

Humanities. *History and Geography.*

History of Wales - looking how Wales, especially Brecon has changed over time. Coal mining and the effect it had on Wales.

Maps - locating continents and countries on a map of the world.

Comparing and contrasting Wales with countries around the world.

Exploring rivers and mountains around the world.

Researching and comparing homes, climate, clothes and foods from countries around the world. Creating a presentation based on a chosen country.

7 wonders of Wales - exploring wonders of Wales. Creating a presentation to persuade tourists to visit the 7 wonders of Wales.

Expressive Arts. *Art, Drama and Music.*

Music - listening, composing, performing and appraising music from around the world. Focus on polyrhythms and use of percussion instruments.

Art - looking at artists from around the world.

Designing and creating a piece of art work inspired by researched artists.

Drama - writing and performing 'A child's Christmas in Wales' linked to book study.

Food Technology, P.S.E. and P.E.

P.S.E - Creating and establishing classroom rules. KiVa. Focus on bullying and feelings. Instruction writing - what makes a happy school? Weekly visits to Trenewydd. Genius hour. Growing up resource. One page profiles.

P.E - PESS Gymnastics. Exploring ways of travelling and movement. Indoor circuits. Outdoor games - focus on ball skills. Food Technology - exploring foods around the world. Focus on Welsh foods: - Picau ar y maen.

Language, Literacy and Communication. *English and Welsh.*

Book studies - Around the world in 80 days, a child's Christmas in Wales and Coming home.

Cornerstones for Writing - writing in the style of a classic story (treasure island). Planning, writing, editing and publishing.

Cornerstones for writing - a balanced argument.

Science and Technology. *Science, D.T. and I.C.T.*

Science - Energy, Light and Sound. Constructing and investigating electric circuits. Carrying out scientific investigations based on energy, light and sound.

D.T - creating a sculpture of chosen landmark from around the world.

I.C.T - using the internet safely to carry out research. Learning how to use J2E to save documents and as a collaborative platform to learning. Using Office 365 (Hwb) to decide how best to present a piece of work. Green screen - news report/ presentation from a chosen country.
