



Questions to Support Hot Seating Baby Bear

Hot Seating is a strategy in which a character or characters, played by the teacher or a pupil, are interviewed by the rest of the group. This activity invites pupils to recount a specific event, explore motivation and multiple perspectives/experiences related to a theme, topic, event, or idea.

Questions:

- Did the Moon feel hot or cold?
- Was it colder or warmer than where we live?
- What did it feel like underneath your feet?
- Was it flat like a park field or rough and bumpy like rocks?
- What could you see?
- Could you see any trees?
- Could you see any plants?
- Could you see any animals?
- If so, what did they look like?
- Did it look like Earth or was it different?
- What could you see when you looked into the sky?
- Was it dark?
- Were there any lights?
- How could you see where you were going?
- What did you need to wear on your feet?
- What colour was the ground?
- Did it take you a long time or short time to walk around?
- Was it big or small?
- Did it make you feel big or small?
- Was it quiet or were there lots of noises?
- What noises could you hear there?
- Did you want to stay or were you ready to come home? Why?
