Independent Project Books

The topic for this term is Dyma ni - Here We Are.



In this topic, we are looking at our homes and how they have changed through the ages. This has included finding out about the inventions that have changed our lives, the food, fashions and the things we do for entertainment.

Each pupil has a project book which they usually take home each day but this term, because of covid, we have to keep them at school. However, we would strongly encourage children to complete some tasks at home to deepen their understanding of the topic. For example, they could:



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- Make a model of a house or castle
- Design a poster showing the musical instruments of the period
- Compare the clothes worn by boys and girls / rich and poor
- Follow a recipe to make traditional food, e.g. scones
- Learn a traditional skill with an older relative, e.g. knitting
- Make a list of all the devices which use electricity in the home
- Interview an older relative about what life was like when they were little
- Use an app to make an animation of children playing a traditional game, such as hoop and stick.

Children can use Hwb to complete tasks and upload to J2E. They can also bring the work into school and stick it into their project books or email pictures to the office.

It is important to note that copying and pasting large passages of information from the internet to a document is not the best way for the children to learn more about a topic. It is beneficial for them to select relevant information that they completely understand in order to be able to complete their project to their best ability.
