Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you to everyone who supported our Meet the Teacher event. This was a new approach for us. We aimed to allow all parents to meet with your children's teachers at a suitable time for you with a less formal feel to the evening. We would welcome any feedback so that we can build on and improve the evening for next year.

This week approximately 6 weeks of building work will begin on the wall surrounding the infant yard. Careful planning has gone into keeping the pupils safe and trying to minimise the disruption to school.
