How do they catch/find their food?</p>	<p>Create a bar graph showing the favourite predators of people in your family. Give them a choice of 6 to choose from, record the answers in a tally chart and then create the graph. Ring other family members to ask them for their answers.</p>	<p>Find out the lengths of 10 predators. Put them in order from the shortest to the longest.</p> <p>Measure your height, where do you come on the list?</p>
