

Corona Virus Time Capsule

Since the Corona Virus has tipped us all up in our learning and our topic, I thought this might be a nice idea until we come up with a new topic for us all to agree on.

These can be historical memories for you to keep, nothing like this has ever happened before! Imagine if you have children and grandchildren and they learn about the corona virus times and you have this evidence of happened? Awesome! These can also be memories for you.

You will need:

- A suitable box or container for storage.
- Lots of memorabilia.
- A bin bag to waterproof.
- A place to store it.

What you can include:

- A local newspaper with headlines about the Corona Virus.
 - Write a recount about what has already happened.
 - A 2020 dated coin or coins.
- A national newspaper with headlines about the Corona Virus.
- A note from each family member and neighbours about what has happened and how they feel.
 - A letter from a grandparent or grandparents.
 - A letter from your parents.
- A letter to yourself including date, age, friends, favourite things, worries, future plans etc.
- Photos of you and family members doing crazy things e.g. dressed up, talking to grandparents through windows, measuring social distancing etc.
- I have included a booklet you can print and add to your time capsule but it's nice to add additional items to really remember the experience!
- Create a diary. Think about what we know about Anne Franks life and her experiences. What did she do? She wrote a diary! Write an entry daily on a piece of paper or in a notebook.
- You could even include this task note to remind yourself of your home learning experience! I would include your home learning book too.

Continue adding bits and pieces to your time capsule until school starts back and life returns to normal. Now comes the real challenge... you need to leave your time capsule for **AT LEAST** 10 years. So, when you are 19/20/21 you can open your time capsule to remind yourself of what you got up to in your last few months of year 5/6.
