

Nursery/Reception Daily Do's

Nursery:

Literacy:

- Practise writing your name
- Listen to Jolly Phonics on You Tube and practise singing the songs
- Read story books and answer questions such as what is your favourite part of the story? Who is your favourite/least favourite character? Talk about the pictures.
- Song and rhyme time, singalong to your favourite nursery rhymes.
- Take part in role play games with a grown up, you could play school, cafe, house, car wash.

Mathematic Development:

- Practise counting forwards and backwards as high as you can
- Practise counting objects, anything you can find around the house or garden. You could count your toys, food, stones.
- Practise your number recognition and ordering numbers up to 10.
- Find shapes around the house (2D shapes square, triangle, rectangle, circle)
- Find items around the home, which is the smallest/biggest? Can you put them in order of size?
- Practise singing our "days of the week" song

Reception Daily Do's

Reception:

Literacy

- Practise writing your first and last name
- Practise your reading everyday, remember you can access more reading books on oxfordowls.co.uk. You can read your book bags or any books you have at home talk about the story, characters and pictures.
- Practise singing through the Jolly Phonics sounds on You Tube.
- Practice making CVC words such as sat, cat, mat, tip, sip, rip etc.
- Practise your letter formation use the formation rhymes in your book bag.
- Practise writing your high frequency words in your book bag.

Mathematic Development

- Practise counting forwards and backwards as high as you can
- Practise counting on from a number e.g. 8, 9, 10, 11...
- Practise counting in 2s and 10s
- Practise ordering numbers and writing numbers all the way up to 20
- Practise counting objects, as many as you can. You could count toys, items you find on a walk or anything you see.
- Find shapes around the house (2D shapes square, triangle, rectangle, circle 3D shapes cubes, cuboid and sphere)
- Find items around the home, which is the longest shortest? Can you put them in order of size?
- Practise singing our "days of the week" song
