<p>Can you complete the worksheets on powerful adjectives? Remember that an adjective is a describing word, we like to use ones that 'wow' us!</p>	<p>Read the story opening about a Jurassic predator. Look at the activities on each sheet and have a try. You can use Hwb or paper to complete the activities.</p>	<p>Can you read the paragraph about the castle and draw a picture to match it? Try to include all of the detail that is described in the paragraph.</p>	<p>Complete the handwriting poem sheet, remember to concentrate and think about the size and shape of your letters. If you can't print the sheet out just practise writing it on a sheet of paper.</p>
<p>Have a try at our flowerpot maths investigation. You must share the seeds out between the pots, make sure that you have the same number of seeds in each pot. How many ways can you share them out?</p>	<p>Can you complete the activities in the Place Value booklet? There are activities for 3-digit and 4-digit numbers.</p>	<p>Fractions are a fun part of maths; can you complete the worksheet? Can you use fractions practically? Try cutting a cake/sandwich/pizza into fractions!</p>	<p>Can you mark the temperatures shown on the thermometers? Try and answer the questions at the bottom of the sheet too.</p>
<p>Print out the predator Top Trumps and play them with your family. Use the template sheet to add some more cards to your pack.</p>	<p>Predators live in different habitats all over the world. Have a try at classifying animals that live in the rainforest. Use the internet or books to research two more animals for the grid.</p>	<p>Look at the Powerpoint about food chains. They are very important in every habitat. Use the worksheets to create some food chains (either use sheet one or sheet two).</p>	<p>Predator and Prey Find the definitions of the words and sort the words to show the features of each animal. I wonder what your favourite animals are?</p>
