

Datganiad Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion

Dyrennir y Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion i ysgolion â disgyblion sy'n dod o deuluoedd incwm isel ac y gwyddys eu bod ar hyn o bryd yn gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim (eFSM). Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim.

Fel ysgol rydym wedi cytuno ar y tri cham a ganlyn:

- Cynllunio ymyriadau sy'n canolbwyntio ar wella cyrhaeddiad disgyblion o gefndiroedd difreintiedig, monitro cynnydd disgyblion yn rheolaidd a gwerthuso effaith yr ymyriadau.
- Integreiddio cynlluniau ar gyfer defnyddio'r Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion yn effeithiol yng nghynllun datblygu'r ysgol, gan seilio ein harfer ar dystiolaeth gadarn a'u cynnwys fel rhan o strategaeth ysgol gyfan.
- Cydbwyso strategaethau ysgol gyfan gydag ymyriadau wedi'u targedu er mwyn sicrhau bod pob dysgwr sydd â hawl i brydau ysgol am ddim yn elwa fel unigolion, tra bod yr ysgol gyfan hefyd yn datblygu ei gallu i gefnogi pob dysgwr i gyflawni ei botensial llawn.

Yn 2020-21, dyrannwyd i Ysgol Gynradd Clydau Grant Amddifadedd disgyblion o £8,050.

Adnoddau Dosbarth – Rydym yn archebu adnoddau ar gyfer y dosbarth cyfan ac felly nid oes rheidrwydd ar unrhyw ddisgybl i archebu offer ar gyfer y diwrnod ysgol e.e. pensiliau, offer lliwio.
Darparu Rhaglen ELSA	Gweithredu cwrs ELSA gyda ffocws penodol ar hunan hyder, hunan reolaeth, ymddygiad a chyfrannu mewn grŵp a sefyllfa cyhoeddus
Gweithgareddau Allgyrsiol	Teithiau Addysgiadol – wrth drefnu rydym yn holi rhieni am gyfraniad tuag at y gost yn hytrach na thâl. Byddwn yn cysylltu â rhieni os nad yw disgybl yn cymryd rhan yn y daith achos cyfyngder arian.

Pupil Deprivation Grant Statement

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (eFSM). Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals.

As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

- Planning interventions that focus on improving the attainment of pupils from deprived backgrounds, regularly monitoring pupils' progress and evaluating the impact of the intervention.
- Integrating plans for the effective use of the PDG into the school development plan, basing our practice on sound evidence and including them as part of a whole school strategy.
- Balancing whole school strategies with targeted interventions to ensure that all learners entitled to free school meals benefit as individuals, whilst the whole school also develops its ability to support every learner to achieve their full potential.

In 2020-21 Ysgol Gynradd Clydau was provided with a PDG allocation of £8,050.

The funds from the grant for 2020-21 were used to:-

Develop enriched Literacy and Numeracy Tasks across the curriculum	Invest in resources to implement rich tasks
Develop basic literacy and numeracy skills by implementing programmes in Mathematics and Language e.g. Tric a Chlic	Intervention Programmes – Tric a Chlic, Sensory Input, in class support to improve literacy and numeracy skills
Develop Literacy and Numeracy Skills	Intervention Programmes – 10 different elements to be taught within the weekly school timetable - Tric a Chlic; Read Write Inc; Accelerated Literacy; Individual Reading Intervention; Numeracy Intervention; MAT Group; Sensory Input; In class support and Group Reading. Class Resources– we order resources for the class to ensure there is no requirement for each pupil to buy their own school equipment e.g. pencils, colouring pencils.
Facilitate ELSA programme	Implement the ELSA course with a specific focus on developing self-esteem, behaviour, group participation and social communication.
Extracurricular Activities	Educational Visits – when organising a visit, we ask parents for a contribution rather than a payment. We will contact parents if a child is unable to attend an educational visit due to financial constraints
