Use the full range of punctuation accurately to clarify meaning.			
Produce fluent and legible handwriting.			
Use varied sentence structures for emphasis and effect.			
Adapt writing style to suit the reader and purpose, e.g. formal for unknown reader, simple for a young reader.			
Use varied vocabulary accurately, including subject-specific words and phrases.			
Use a variety of strategies to spell complex and irregular words.			
Use appropriate language, including standard forms of English, e.g. tense, person.			
Write a detailed account of a topic or theme.			
Use paragraphs consistently, making links between them.			
Write an effective introduction that establishes context and purpose.			
Write with a suitable balance between facts and viewpoints.			
Write a precise conclusion, appropriate to the main body of writing.			
Present work using ICT in various ways e.g. moving image, slideshow, voice over.			
Reflect on, edit and redraft to improve writing.			
Use various features and layout to present data and ideas clearly.			
Adapt structure for context, e.g. reporting an event, investigation or experiment.			
Use a range of strategies to plan writing, e.g. notes, diagrams, flowcharts.
