





## Learning Activities: Nursery/Reception

Below are a list of activities for you to complete with your child this week. You can contact me by email or through learning conversations on your child's Hwb account. Literacy	
1	Spelling – make a list of words (3 or 4 letters long) beginning or ending with ‘a’ and ‘t’. You can write the words in interesting ways – different coloured pens, paints, use of chalk outside, in sand etc. <b>Examples – and, pat, hand, lamp, tap, hat, spot, twin</b>
2	Writing – Use Hwb (Just2easy/Jit/Mix) to draw a sea creature and write a sentence about them. I will be able to have a learning conversation with you by clicking on the speech bubble icon once you have saved your work. You can also complete on paper and email me a photo of the work, if you wish - <a href="mailto:SmithK165@hwbcymru.net">SmithK165@hwbcymru.net</a> <b>Sentence examples</b> – The fish is orange and swims in the sea. A crab likes to hide under rocks.
3	Reading – Read 2 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).

Numeracy	
1	Shape – name circles, triangles and squares. Find objects of each shape around the house or in the garden. Count how many you can find of each. Have a go at drawing each shape (younger pupils may need you to draw the shapes and they can colour the shapes different colours e.g. all the triangles green, circles red etc.)

3	Shape – create a shape picture of a fish or boat (or anything else linked to the sea) by cutting out or drawing different shapes. Have a look at these examples for some ideas:

Create a dance using movements seen in the video - can you swim like fish, dive like dolphins, sway like coral or scuttle like crabs? 2	Art – create an underwater art work. You can use any materials you wish to create your piece of art – paints, junk modelling, collage, crayons, felt pens etc.
