Literacy	
1	Spelling – make a list of words (3 or 4 letters long) that have 'i' and 'p' in them. You can write the words in interesting ways – different coloured pens, paints, use of chalk outside, in sand etc. <b>Examples – ink, pig, pin, bin, pond, link</b> <b>Extension – (Reception pupils only if above words are too easy)</b> <b>ai words - pain, tail, brain, mail, stain</b>
2	Writing – Use Hwb (Just2easy/Jit/Mix) to draw a rainbow fish. Write a list of the colours you have used in your drawing. You could even write some of these colours in Welsh! I will be able to have a learning conversation with you by clicking on the speech bubble icon once you have saved your work. If you wish to do this activity on paper then please send me a photo by email or save to Hwb.
3	Reading – Read 2 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).

Numeracy	
1	Counting – Open the file named 'Counting under the sea' (found in Hwb/Just2Easy/My files/shared files). Have a go at counting the sea creatures. There are 3 versions of the worksheet with lower/higher numbers, please use the version your child is capable of.
2	Counting – play the underwater counting game using a computer, tablet or mobile device. Upload a photo of yourself playing the game to Hwb or send to my email. 3	Pattern – complete the pattern worksheet (attached below or found on Hwb). This can be printed out or your child can draw the correct answers on a sheet of paper. Use the version most suited to your child. Why not try making your own pattern out of object in the house. For example, different coloured lego or different fruits.

Topic – Under the Sea	
1	PE – Create and complete an 'Under the sea' themed circuit around the house or garden. You could add 'Starfish' jumps, twisting coral (twist your body in different directions) and 'shark' runs (jogging with your hand above your head like a fin). Try using a stopwatch to time how long it takes you to complete.
2	DT – Design and create a model of a boat. It can be made out of any materials you have around the house. Try putting your boat in a bowl of water and seeing if it floats or make a few boats and use straws to blow them across a bath!
