Literacy	
1	Spelling / handwriting– make a list of words that have the sound 'ch' in them. You can write the words in interesting ways – different coloured pens, paints, use of chalk outside, in sand, in shaving foam, etc. At the same time, practice your handwriting. Year 2 try joining. Let's see who can get a pen licence point. Examples – chip / church / chop / chat. Which is the longest word that you can spell?
2	Reading & oracy – Read 1 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).
3	Download the plant research report plan from your Hwb account. Then complete it.

Numeracy	
1	You need some items to weigh, 2 sheets of paper with heavy and light and a weighing scale if possible (maybe a cooking activity). Compare (by holding them in each hand or by using the scales) the weight of two items at a time and sort them, use language such as heavy, light, heaviest, lightest, heavier, lighter, weight, mass, measuring scale. Guess which item is the heaviest before picking it up. Find out if you were right? Try for other items.
2	Use the scales on the measuring scale if you have one to find out how much items weigh in grams and kilograms. Order the items by how heavy they are. Record some of your activities/ findings. Can you find out and record how many grams are in 1kg / 2kg / 4kg / etc.?

Topic – Growing Things	
1	Talk about the life cycle of a plant; how it grows from a seed or a bulb. Investigate seeds from different plants.
2	Download the fruit plant life cycle sheets from your Hwb account. Use them to cut out and order the cards showing how a fruit plant grows.
3	Design a scarecrow to protect the plants in your garden. Can you label the materials that you'd need if you made it? Can you actually make it?
