



Learning Activities: Years 1 & 2

Week Commencing: 4th May 2020



Below are a list of activities / **challenges** for you to complete with your child this week. You can contact me by email or through learning conversations on your child's Hwb account. Literacy	
1	Spelling / handwriting– make a list of words made up from the letters ' g, o, u, l, f, b' and previous week's letters . You can write the words in interesting ways – different coloured pens, paints, use of chalk outside, in sand, in shaving foam, etc. At the same time, practice your handwriting. Year 2 try joining. Let's see who can get a pen licence point. Examples – get / leg / best / plug. Which is the longest word that you can spell?
2	Reading & oracy – Read 1 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book). Perform the story of 'Jack & the Beanstalk', record it and upload it onto your Hwb account – continue with this.
3	Writing – draw a story map of Jack and the Beanstalk. There's a copy on your Hwb accounts to help.

Numeracy	
1	Talk about the time of day and draw what you do e.g. breakfast time - morning, lunch time – afternoon. Use time words such as today, yesterday and tomorrow. Look at a calendar or diary to find special days e.g. Christmas. Write out the birthdays of family members using days, dates, months and years. Record some of your challenges. You can use your HWB account to record.
2	Learn the days of the week and put them in the correct order. Can you say them in Welsh too? Year 2: Learn the months of the year and put these in the correct order.
3	Learn your birthday, find it on the calendar. Do this for your family too. On Hwb go to JiT – data – chart. Produce a birthday months of the year graph of your family. You may have to phone some of them up to find out this information.

Topic – Growing Things	
1	Make a list of types of plants and gather some examples: tree – oak, holly, ash, etc. / flower – daisy, rose, tulip, etc. / vegetable: potato, carrot, pea, etc. / fruit: apple, banana, orange, etc.
2	Collect some plants from your garden: leaves / grass / petals. Dry these out then make a collage picture from them.

Go into your garden and write a list of plants that you see. Record how many of each that you see: e.g. trees = 2 / flowers = 15 / weeds = 0 / etc. On Hwb produce another graph titled 'plants in my garden'. **Can you use a tally chart to count: ~~////~~?**
