



Learning Activities: Years 1 & 2

Below are a list of activities / **challenges** for you to complete with your child this week. You can contact me by email or through learning conversations on your child's Hwb account. Literacy	
1	Spelling / handwriting– make a list of words made up from the letters ' v, y, x ' and previous week's letters . You can write the words in interesting ways – different coloured pens, paints, use of chalk outside, in sand, in shaving foam, etc. At the same time, practice your handwriting. Year 2 try joining. Let's see who can get a pen licence point. Examples – vet / yes / fox / flex. Which is the longest word that you can spell?
2	Reading & oracy – Read 1 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).
3	Cut and paste the story of Jack and the Beanstalk in the correct order – this is in your Hwb account.

Numeracy	
1	How many different ways can you make 5p using coins? Make a 'shop' what can you buy with 5p? How many different ways can you make 10p using coins? Make a 'shop' what can you buy with 10p? How many different ways can you make 20p using coins? Make a 'shop' what can you buy with 20p? How many different ways can you make 50p using coins? Make a 'shop' what can you buy with 50p? Year 2: How many different ways can you make £1 & £2 using coins? Make a 'shop' what can you buy with £1 and £2? Record the different ways you can make the amounts/ what you could buy in your pretend shop. Can you give change?

Topic – Growing Things	
1	Make an obstacle course in your garden – write some directions using language such as forwards / right / left / backwards / steps – ask a family member to go around the course whilst blindfolded with you reading them the instructions.

2	Make a model of a plant. You can choose any type of plant and use any materials to make it: junk / Lego / paper Mache / etc.
3	Answer the question: 'Why do we need plants?' Can you think of 3 or more reasons why we need plants?
