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Topic – Wild Wood

1	<p><u>Woodland trees</u> Using your garden or local area, identify, name and explore trees found in the local environment. Take bark rubbings, leaf prints, measure girth of tree, note any special features, look for flowers or fruit. Allocate trees to pairs or groups to research and create a database/scrapbook. Discuss what happens to the trees in winter – are there any that do not lose their leaves – difference between coniferous and deciduous. N.B the Sessile Oak (also called The Welsh Oak) is the national tree of Wales. The Rowan (common name Mountain Ash) features in a lot of Welsh folklore and stories. There are leaf and twig identification sheets in the Shared file to help you identify trees that you find. 4 PE	<p><u>Outdoor Adventurous Activities</u> Teamwork – Lean Walking This activity is a trust exercise and only works if done with someone of a similar height to you. • Stand side by side with a partner. • At the same time, you must both lean sideways towards each other so that your upper arm and shoulder are touching. • Next, each person must shift their feet away from their partner as far as they feel comfortable. • When ready, try to walk a few paces forwards while maintaining your leaning position. • If comfortable, try and walk to an agreed point. • Now, swap sides and try leaning on the other shoulder.</p>
