1	<p><b>Spelling</b></p> <p>Log into J2Launch and select J2 Blast, then select Spell-blaster. Choose 'Practice' section, and then choose 'Year 5/6' spelling words using the slider. Use Spell Blaster to practice these spelling words. The words will increase in difficulty the more you get correct.
