



Learning Activities: Nursery/Reception

Below are a list of activities for you to complete with your child this week. You can contact me by email or through learning conversations on your child's Hwb account. Literacy	
1	Spelling – make a list of words (3-6 letters long) that have 'u' or 'l' in them. You can write the words in interesting ways – coloured pens, paints, chalk outside, sand etc. Examples – up, cup, upset, lost, lamp, lemon Extension – (Reception pupils only if above words are too easy) oo words – book, took, look, shook
2	Writing – Describe your favourite farm or jungle animal – What do they look like? Where do they live? What do they eat? Reception – Write sentences independently about their chosen animal. Nursery – Give words orally about their animal and overwrite words.
3	Reading – Read 2 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).

Numeracy	
1	Data collection – Collect different toy animals from around your house - cuddly toys, pictures, plastic figurines (Peppa Pig/Paw Patrol figures for example). Now group these animals in different ways and count and record how many are in each group. Examples of different groupings you could use: Farm animals – 3 Stripes – 2 No legs - 1 Jungle animals – 7 Spots – 5 Two legs - 3 Ocean animals – 5 Plain – 9 Four legs - 8
2	Data collection – Log into your hwb account. Open Just2easy from the menu. Click on JiT5 and click the pictogram tab (top right hand menu). Create a pictogram to show your family's favourite animals by adding the animals from the left hand side to your chart. Why not ring some of your family and friends and ask them what their favourite animals are too?
3	Data Collection – Play the Curious George game to collect hats and find out which colour hat is the most popular https://pbskids.org/curiousgeorge/busyday/hats/

Topic – Animals	
1	Art – Make a junk model, collage or painting of your favourite animal. Extension – Make a model jungle or farmyard for your animal to play in!
2	Music – Watch this video about different animal sounds. Create your own piece of animal sound music using your voice, instruments or various household objects. Record a clip of it and upload to hwb or send to me via email. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=14LDUtA7G84
