Literacy	
1	Spelling – make a list of words (3-6 letters long) that have 'v', 'y' or 'x' in them. You can write the words in interesting ways – coloured pens, paints, chalk outside, sand etc. <b>Examples – van, vet, yes, yet, fix, six</b> <b>Extension – (Reception pupils only if above words are too easy)</b> <b>qu words – quack, quick, queen, quest</b>
2	Writing – Choose 3-5 of the tricky words that we have been learning for the last few weeks and write (Nursery can overwrite) sentences with them in. Choose from the list below.  I            the            he            she            me            we was        to            do            are            all            be
3	Reading – Read 2 of the assigned books on Bug Club, complete the quiz activities (click on the Bug icon throughout the book).

Numeracy	
1	Pattern – Work through the pattern activities using the link below. 2	Time – Learn to tell time to the hour with the game linked below – scroll down to 'play', click on the option 'Read time to the hour'. 3	Time – Make your own clock face out of card or junk modelling materials. Make sure you write all the numbers to 12 in the correct place. Why not make an animal themed clock?

1	Art – Make a collage to show animal prints. You could pick one animal like a zebra or pick a few different animal prints to collage in your work.  
2	Science – Have a look at the pictures of different habitats attached. Make a list or draw some animals that you think live in each habitat.
