### **Muddy Monday**

Wellies and a waterproof coat will be required every Monday for outdoor learning activities which will take place within the school grounds.

### **PE**

PE will be every Thursday and Friday. Your child should come to school dressed in their PE kit - white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers. Black jogging bottoms/leggings are recommended for when the weather turns cooler.

### **Reading**

Reading books will be changed every Monday and Thursday. Please record the title of each book inside their reading record and write a brief comment each time to indicate how they are getting on. To keep books tidy we recommend you purchase a school book bag, which can be purchased from the school office.

### **Homework**

Both Literacy and Numeracy homework will be uploaded to the HWB 'homework' platform every Monday. The children will be able to access this using their HWB logins. The children are expected to complete the activities within seven days and then they will be rewarded for their effort with stars.

### **Labelling**

Please ensure that all lunch boxes, water bottles, book bags and clothes (especially fleeces and jumpers) are clearly labelled.

### **Accidents**

Please send a change of spare clothes in your child's school bag in case they have an accident and need changing.

### **Lunch**

Children are asked during registration if they are having packed lunch or school dinners. If they require a school dinner, they can order it at this time and parents can pay for the meal via 'ParentPay'.

### **Water/Snack**

Please ensure your child has a water bottle and healthy piece of fruit every day for snack time. Please note we have children with allergies to nuts, peaches and nectarines so please be mindful not to send these food items into school.

### **Toys**

Current COVID guidance dictates that unnecessary items such as toys are not allowed in school.
