PROJECT

2013 - 2014

Work began in Autumn 2013 with each group of pupils having 10 dance sessions.



The pupils chose different texts each having a theme of sharing and giving, to interpret through creative movement and dance - "My Many Coloured Days", "The Smartest Giant in Town" and "The Rainbow Fish."



Public performance - A 'taster' was shown at the Christmas Concert, then a January performance in school for parents, a performance in February at Plas Cae Crwn and finally at the Park Day Centre in April.



In addition to developing Music and Movement skills, the project has helped with Language and Communication, Personal and Social Education, Literacy, Numeracy, Art and Craft and RE - through sharing and co-operating.
