WALT listen to a story
WALT draw a picture from the story and talk about it
- Summer Pencil Control Maze Nursery
WALT hold a pencil to draw lines

WALT recognise our different colours

Mathematical Development

- I would like you to work with your child on creating an Ice Cream stall/shop/van. Take it in turns to be the shopkeeper/customer
WALT use coins to pay
- Use 1p coins and price tags. Ask your child to give you the correct amount of money. Encourage them to count it out.
WALT read numbers to 5
WALT count reliably
- Give them 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins. Help them to sort into groups.
WALT recognise and sort coins

Topic (Science & Technology, Humanities, Expressive Arts & Health and Wellbeing)

- Changing materials - Exploring how materials change when they are frozen. Easy Peasy Ice Cream Recipe and Recipe Ideas Ice Lollies
WALT explore how ingredients change
- Staying Safe in the Sun - Talk to the children about how to stay safe in the sun. If possible, use actual objects and question them:- What is this called? What do we use it for? How do we use it? Show me? What do you think will help to keep us safe in the sun?
