### Daily Activities

- Share a story

- Sing Nursery Rhymes
- Overwriting/copying their first name (Please use RWI letter formation sheet)
- Writing numbers 0 to 5 (using the formation rhymes)
- Spending time outdoors/exercise

### Language, Literacy & Communication

- What the Ladybird Heard on Holiday - Story Read Aloud <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uws1OsSeutI>  
WALT listen to a story  
WALT draw a picture from the story and talk about it
- Summer Pencil Control Nursery  
WALT hold a pencil to track over lines
- Summer I Spy with My Eye activity. Point to the . . . ?  
Count how many . . . there are altogether? (The children do not need to record) Can you find a picture beginning with . . . ?  
WALT recognise and name pictures
- Listen and Colour - Parent/Carer to read instructions and children to follow these  
WALT listen and follow instructions

### Mathematical Development

- 2D shape hunt  
Ask the children questions:-  
Can you point to a . . . ? What is the name of this shape?  
Count how many . . . ? Colour the . . . red  
WALT recognise and name 2D shapes (circle, square, triangle)  
*Challenge to recognise and name a rectangle*

- Matching Number Colouring Activity
- Counting and matching puzzle to 5  
*Challenge to 10*  
WALT count and recognise numbers
- Writing Numbers - Adult to use objects/draw pictures.  
Question: Count how many? Can you write the number? to 5  
*Challenge to 10*  
WALT to count reliably and write numbers

### Topic (Science & Technology, Humanities, Expressive Arts & Health and Wellbeing)

- Shadow Drawing - Children explore how a shadow changes and uses this to make marks.  
WALT hold a pencil and draw an outline
- Floating and Sinking - Children experiment with which objects float/sink  
WALT explore and experiment
- Singing - 'Summer in the Garden Song' and 'The Sun Cream Song'  
WALT join in a song  
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- Create a Sun face using different materials e.g. pens, pencils, materials, chalk, paint, collage  
WALT explore materials to create a picture
