21/1/19

- Meeting of partners and welcome meal.

22 /1/19

- Travel to Fritz Felsenstein Haus
- Welcome to the school
- Welcome assembly
- Assembly to introduce the new school principle of Thankful. All pupils introduced to the principle – ideas shared for how to be thankful, each partner school shared how to say thank you in their own language. All pupils engaged in the Gentle song.

 - Confirmed details for the rest of the week – where to meet and times
 - Discussions around pupil visit to Italy in May – wheelchair accessibility for students.
 - Savina to arrange transport to and from airport.
 - Savina needs all partner schools flights details ASAP.
 - Discussions began around accommodation to Germany for pupils in March 2020
 - All partner schools to check the website and send any up to date information to Savina to upload
 - School house rules – Savina shared her presentation – all other schools to develop this area of work in Italy.
 - Ambassadors – create ambassadors in Italy, prepare students attending to become ambassadors.
 - Italy 2020 – Savina will arrange a debate on Inclusion
 - Elke shared her work on the use of plain language – this has been translated into English and needs to be added to the website.
 - Germany is in the process of creating a blog site on the school website and school Facebook page. Insert links on website and twin space page.
 - Germany is running a whole school completion on the pillars
 - All partner schools to create a postcard on the pillars to take to Italy.
 - All partner schools are preparing for European Day on May 9th
 - Italy shared their video of the visit to wales
 - Italy will translate the ‘What I like’ booklet into different languages – Arabic
 - Results of dissemination are on the website.
 - Barcelona are using programmes to develop the comics.

- Whole staff are looking at methodology manual of good practice of gentle teaching principles.
