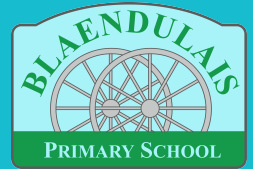
Building Work

School Day

A reminder that the school day begins at 8.50am. A member of staff is on duty on the Junior Yard from 8.40am - pupils arriving before 8.40am will not be supervised and it is advisable not to allow them to arrive before this time. Infant pupils (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) will be met at the classroom door from 8.40am onward. Nursery begins at 12.45pm. Pupils arriving after registration must inform the office of their arrival - this will ensure that attendance and dinner registers are accurate.

Dinner Money

Dinner money must be paid for the week on Monday - £2.30 per day or £11.50 per week. Any credit will be returned the following week. If dinner money is unpaid, then a healthy packed lunch must be provided.
