

Maths: Week Beginning 20th April

Year 1 objectives:

Recognise and understand odd and even numbers up to 20

Count in 5's up to 50- then back again

Recall 'one more' of a number up to 20

Recall 'one less' of a number up to 20

Compare and order numbers up to 20, saying which numbers are 1 more, 1 less, and give a number in between them

Year 2 objectives:

Count on and backwards in steps of 3 or 4. Forwards and backwards from zero

Compare and order 2-digit numbers

Activities:

Use J2Blast to practise 3,4,5 times tables. Alternatively, use the link to the times tables chart to help you practise.

Use the link to the 'Number Square' (or create your own) to help find number that are 1 less/1 more

Generate 2 digit numbers using 2 dice, or make your own number cards to pick out.

Can you write the number that is 1 more, 1 less and give a number that falls in between.

Play with a partner if you can.

Using your number cards, or numbers that you've generated with dice, can you order them into ODD or EVEN piles?

TOPIC CHALLENGE: find and measure different plants in your garden. Which is the tallest? Which is the shortest?... Are the measurements ODD or EVEN numbers?
