- **Activity 1- English writing.**

Remember that brilliant news writing you did yesterday? Well now we are going to use coloured pencils / pens / crayons to circle examples of these in our work -

**Capital letters**

**Full stops**

**Finger spaces**

**A tall letter**

**A long letter**

**A description of something – weather, person, object or animal.**

**Commas (if listing things)**

- **Writing capital letters correctly**

- **Write a sentence about yourself- remember finger spaces in between words**

**Example- we need apples, plums, carrots and cheese.**

- **Activity 2- Topic**
