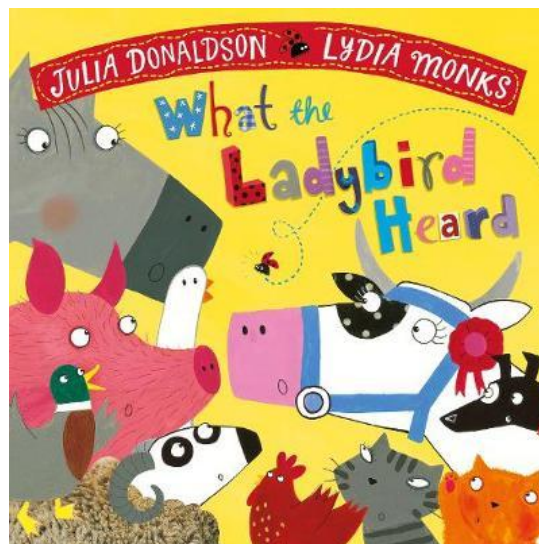




## Languages, Literacy and Communication

### Story Activities:

- Talk about the story together
- Point to some of the words when you are saying them
- Encourage your child to tell you the story themselves
- Talk about their favourite part of the story
- What if something different happened at the end?
- Which animals and mini beasts from the story have they seen in real life or in different books?
- Try to identify the rhyming words together (see this week’s Phonics activity on rhyming too) – can you hear the words at the end of the sentences that rhyme?
- Look up the Welsh word for pig, cow and horse and practise saying the Welsh words together: [English to Welsh translation](#)
