3. Process painting with natural materials

Process art is all about the experience rather than the end result! This activity is a great way to explore different textures and designs without using a paintbrush.

As part of Health and Well being we set you the challenge of going on a nature walk to collect natural materials. We are going to use these natural materials to paint with.

You will need:

- Paint red, yellow and brown if you have them but any three colours will work
- Paper
- Natural materials leaves, sticks, grass, flowers, stones

What to do:

- Simply dip your different natural materials into the paint and start painting and printing onto your paper.
- What shapes and marks can you make?
- If you hold the material in different places does it make different patterns?
