- Read and talk about the story together. Look at some of the words together and practise saying them out loud whilst pointing to the word.
- Encourage your child to retell the story themselves – reading out loud some of the words they are familiar with. Talk about their favourite part of the story.
- What if something different happened at the end?
- Can you write some speech bubbles for what the characters say in the story. Can you write 'Not I' like the animals say when they won't help the little red hen. (Or mums and dads can you write down the words your child tells you to put).

- Story Maps- A story map can be used to help you re-tell the story using pictures, images and key words to help you remember. Here are some examples of story maps below. You could make your own to help you retell the story or use the examples below.
