**HEADLICE**

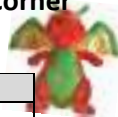

**MATHS OF THE MONTH (OCTOBER) : TIME**

We set out below what a child is likely to be able to do in each year group. Please practice some of these with your child each week for this month.

Thank you for your support.

YN	Accept a wait for an activity using ideas such as first, then, next, after
YR	Use the concept of time in terms of daily activities
Y1	Read O'clock on analogue and digital clocks
Y2	Read half past, quarter to and quarter past on an analogue clock
Y3	tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes on an analogue clock and calculate how long it is to the next hour
Y4	tell the time to the nearest minute on analogue clocks
Y5	read and use analogue and digital clocks
Y6	convert between standard units of time (eg 2 hours is 120 mins, half an hour is 30 mins, 1 day is 1440 mins etc)
Challenge	Use time zones
