We set out below what a child is likely to be able to do in each year group. Please practice some of these with your child each week for this month.
Thank you for your support.

YN	• use words that describe temperature during everyday activities, e.g. hot/cold
YR	• use direct comparisons when describing temperature, e.g. hot/cold
Y1	• use descriptive words for a range of temperatures, e.g. cooler/warmer
Y2	• compare daily temperatures using a thermometer (°C)
Y3 & Y4	• take temperature readings using thermometers and interpret readings
Y5 & Y6	• calculate temperature differences
Ext	• convert temperatures between appropriate temperature scales
