MATHS OF THE MONTH (JUNE) – CAPACITY

We set out below what a child is likely to be able to do in each year group. Please practice some of these with your child each week for this month.
Thank you for your support.

YN & YR	
Y1	• Compare the capacity of two objects, eg Does the bucket hold more or less than the bottle?
Y2	• use non-standard units to measure capacity, eg the bucket holds how many jugs of water?
Y3	• Measure capacity in litres.
Y4	• measure to the nearest 100ml.
Y5	• measure capacities to the nearest 50ml or 100ml
Y6	• make use of conversions, e.g. $\frac{1}{4}$ of a litre = 250ml.
Y6	• use the language of imperial units in daily use, e.g. miles, pints.
Ext	• convert between units of the metric system and carry out calculations.
