<p>Ask an adult to hide the numbers to 10 (or more) around your room, house or garden. See if you can find them and place them in order.</p> <p>You could ask someone to tell you a number to find. Can you remember what the number looks like and can you find it?</p>	<p>Master a new skill, tying a shoelace, doing up your own buttons or riding a bike!</p>	<p>Choose some music to listen to and make up your own dance to it!</p> 	<p>Think of six games/activities you would like to do.</p> <p>Make a spinner and whatever the spinner lands on is the activity to do first.</p>
<p>Draw a picture of a person who has helped you in the last few weeks.</p> <p>Say thank you to them in Welsh!</p>	<p>Ask an adult to tell you a number. Place this number on items on a table. If your grown-up says 'one more', can you add one more and say the number you have? If your grown-up says 'one less', can you tell them?</p>	<p>Make a time capsule. What would you put inside a box to open in one, five or even ten years time!</p>	<p>Close your eyes and ask a partner to pass you an object that you can hold in your hands.</p> <p>Touch and turn the object and guess what it is.</p> <p>Take turns to have a go!</p>
<p>Use the Internet or books to look at patterns on animals. Look at tigers, zebras, snakes, giraffes and cheetahs. What other animals can you find with patterns? Can you draw any of the patterns? Can you use Jit to draw them? Remember to save your work.</p>	<p>Have a picnic lunch outside in the garden with your favourite teddy bear.</p> 	<p>Spread out some plastic tubs or old boxes on the floor. Make some paper balls or find some soft objects. Try to throw the ball or object into the targets. If you find this easy, move further away from the target!</p>	<p>Create your own den in the garden.</p> <p>Can you count how many birds you can see in your garden in five minutes.</p>
