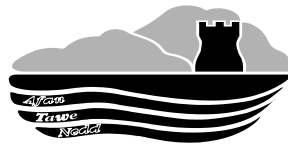

Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you for your patience during the settling in period of the new term during the current climate. After much discussion and consultation as a staff we will be using the following arrangements to support your children with their reading in school and at home:

- Reading books will be sent home from Friday 9th October. Please read with your children regularly at home and fill in the reading record accordingly.
- Books need to be returned daily to school in the event that there is an opportunity to listen to your child read.
- Children (where age appropriate) will be responsible for getting their books out of their bag and returning them to their bags once they have read.
- Staff will be wearing PPE (gloves, mask/ visor) when listening to readers.
- In order to minimise contact learners will be encouraged to hold their book and turn the pages themselves.
- Books which have been changed in school will be quarantined for a period of 72 hours before being available for another pupil to bring home.
- Pupils without a reading scheme book will receive a sound/ tricky word mat that can be kept at home for to practise daily alongside flash cards kept and used in class.
