Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are now probably fully aware, our school is closed to most of our pupils until the 18<sup>th</sup> of January. Our staff will provide work on-line as we did through the Spring and Summer of 2020; we will also look at how we can develop what we share through the Internet. Teachers will use Teams to communicate with their classes and we hope to maintain the little phone calls home we had in the past too.

Our school is open for Key Worker Pupils from this Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> January.

We intend to create **two** Key Worker 'bubbles' - If your child is usually taught in the Junior building (Mr Hopkins, Mrs Wonnacott and Mrs Begum's classes) they will be supported in the Junior Building. If your child is usually taught in the Infant building (Mrs Harris, Mrs Griffiths and Mrs Elias' classes) they will be supported in the Infant building.

**School will start at 8.50** - Junior pupils will enter the Junior building through the junior yard and through Mr Hopkins and Mrs Wonnacott's cloakroom. Infant Key Worker pupils will enter the Infant building through the **Nursery door**. School will end at 3.20 and Junior building pupils will leave into the Junior yard and Infant building pupils will need to be collected from the Nursery door. If there is a problem with younger brothers or sisters, please let us know and we can 'look after' certain pupils for a minute or so. Pupils can have school dinners or packed lunch, the kitchen will be open. Can I remind everyone that our safety rules are still in place - There is no need for school uniform, no need for rucksacks/bags (sandwiches in a disposable bag is great), there can be no 'sharing' of property between school and home without permission and each pupil will need their own water bottle. We need to keep our buildings well ventilated and we will be using the outside a lot; coats, jackets and lots of layers will be very important.

Breakfast Club will be open from 8.15. Key worker pupils need to come to the main Junior entrance if you need Breakfast Club. Our 'bubbles' will be kept separate in the hall and will then join their correct group when school begins.

Information is changing very quickly, but I will do my very best to share the information I have with you as soon as is possible.

I want to say thank you again for your support and understanding. The way Tonna families have looked after our school is much appreciated.
