Breakfast club

We hope to start a new Breakfast Club - next Tuesday 16th March. In order to keep everyone safe, this term's breakfast Club will look very similar to the Autumn Term.

Spaces in Breakfast Club will be limited to 30 pupils. To be part of Breakfast Club you must phone the school on 01639 637062 - places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis - once allocated a space, the space is yours - we don't have the office staff to take 'bookings' for different days. The Breakfast Club is for families that really need it - If families are able to arrive at school for the usual times or don't need to leave home for work, I would ask that you help us keep numbers to a safe and manageable level.

Each class will have their own table in the hall - seven tables for our seven class 'bubbles'. (a table for Mrs Harris' class, a table for Mrs Griffiths' class etc.). Pupils will be met at the main front door by Breakfast Club staff. Pupils will remain at their tables throughout their time in breakfast club: we will put CBBC/Tom and Jerry on the screen in the hall and pupils will watch this.

When breakfast club is over, pupils will be collected from the hall by staff from their own class bubble and taken safely into class.

Breakfast Club will start at 8.15. This later start means Breakfast Club will end at 8.45, which means school staff can safely collect pupils, take pupils to classrooms and be immediately ready for the start of the school day.

This pattern may not be perfect and I apologise that the system may not support all families. However, the safety of our pupils and staff is paramount - The main priority of our Breakfast Club is to support the families that really need it in the safest way possible.

Tonnau families have been a huge support to our school these past few months; we are massively reliant upon your continued support and understanding in the future.
