I want to reassure you that before, the school is closed, we are continuing to plan for learning to continue during the closure by preparing resources which will be made available to you and your child(ren). This will be sent out separately.

Furthermore, teachers, will still communicate weekly with their classes via Hwb and other ways which will be shared tomorrow and I will check in with you all regularly through twitter and text messages.

I urge you all to take care of yourselves and of each other and to follow the medical advice being given. If the advice is to avoid certain situations and to stay indoors for certain periods, then this is what we all must do.
