We would be so grateful if you could share this call-out so that your staff, pupils and their families can get involved and appear in our film.

Be a part of our feature film

We're co-creating a 60 minute film that will be screened at an outdoor cinema at venues across Pembrokeshire. We'll be telling a story about our protagonist Dryw, who meets different community members to learn from ancient wisdom about how he can forge a future in harmony with the land. This is where you come in. We'd like to feature short videos shot by you in your own environments. Have you made a family member a gift? Have you been on a walk in a green space? Have you been kind to a neighbour? Have you taken a moment to look up at a blanket of stars?

We want to show the people of Pembrokeshire and beyond in all their glorious variety, so whatever your age or background, we want you! This is also a perfect family activity and we'd welcome videos showing you all together (complying with current restrictions, of course...)


Option 1: Simple Acts. This could be you cooking at home. It might be a short film of your child playing on the beach. Anything that you feel represents the joy of our 7 Simple Acts:

1. Plant a seed
2. Learn one new thing about nature
3. Take a walk
4. Connect with someone new
5. Consume a little less
6. Be kind to your neighbour
7. Consider the stars

Option 2: Holding up a light. At the end of the feature film we'll show people coming together holding up a light to banish darkness. Film yourself holding up a candle or another form of light with a sense of positivity.

What to film

Please send us an unedited clip between 10 seconds to 30 seconds in length.
It must be filmed landscape not portrait



You can film on any device, including mobile phone, camcorder, DSLR. You do not need to be a professional filmmaker – whatever the quality of the footage, we can use it. We just want to see you on screen.

We will not be using the sound from your clips, so capture visual actions rather than speaking to camera.

What will we accept?

Any quality whatsoever!

Any file format – we can accept .mp4, .mov, or any other type of video file.

What won't we accept?

We won't accept anything with swearing or inappropriate material
