Attendance

We have set our attendance target again this year at 95%. I have spoken to Governors and it has been decided again that any absence under 95% will not be authorised for holidays. Medical appointments are different. If your child is ill this still counts as an absence. We have Attendance as a target for improvement from our Estyn inspection recommendations and we therefore must try to improve it. I am very pleased to say that so far it is looking positive and we have very few children arriving late. I hope it continues to improve. Governors and myself are looking into the fixed penalty notices and whether it is something we need to adopt next September in line with other schools within the cluster. This is primarily designed to target parents who have regular days off each week such as a Friday and a Monday or who take a significant amount of holidays in term time. It is something I would appreciate your thoughts on at the next parent council on Wednesday 13th November. The agenda for the next meeting will be sent out shortly.
