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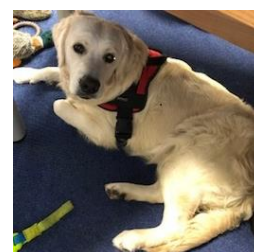
Dear Mums and Dads

Thank you for sending your children in, in such great costumes for world book day. The children enjoyed a day where they were immersed in stories and literature.



Our Eisteddfod went really well and all the children enjoyed taking part. It was very difficult for the teachers to judge the competitions as the standards were so high. Our children are all amazingly talented.

Hadleigh has been into school today to say hello to the children and we are slowly introducing him to school life. The children have all been brilliant at just saying hello to him and they are very keen to begin reading to him.



Thank you to all the parents who completed the school questionnaire. Overall the results were excellent in all areas. However 5% of you don't agree that the homework builds on previous knowledge. We will be reviewing this in line with the new curriculum, however our aim has always been to share the learning experiences the children have in school with you at home to consolidate learning. 2% didn't feel their child had enough support in school and 2% don't feel their child is prepared for transition. Links with the juniors have gone from strength to strength over the past 4 years and we work closely with them to provide a smooth transition. We have already begun the transition process of sharing knowledge and the junior teachers will be coming to our school to meet the children this week. We also monitor every child in school to ensure that they receive extra provision where it is needed and offer a wide range of programmes dependent on the needs of the child.



8% were not aware of the complaints procedure. There is a leaflet in reception that gives you guidelines. In the first instance you would be expected to meet with the teacher, then you would meet with Miss Stow and the teacher and then you would meet with myself. Overall comments were very positive with parents commenting on the success of Forest Schools, Dojo, Parental engagement, Additional support for pupils and the nurturing and approachable staff within the school.

I am following up again on the use of a cashless system with the LA and I am also looking at the possibility of extending the time for breakfast club.
