As we are seeing a rise locally in Covid cases, please take the time to familiarise yourself with our arrangements. This letter is also on the website, named December 2020 Newsletter. Working together we can reduce the risk to the school community.

### COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Please do not send your child to school if they or any other household members have any of the following symptoms: temperature, persistent cough and/or loss of taste and smell. If your child or any household member has a positive Covid test result, please telephone the school as soon as possible.

If a positive test result is received out of school hours for a pupil, including during holiday periods, then please contact us on our dedicated email address – [covid.catwgprimary@npt.gov.uk](mailto:covid.catwgprimary@npt.gov.uk) – this is monitored regularly. **This email should only be used to notify us if a pupil has a positive test result out of school hours.**

**If your child or any household member books a Covid test, all children must stay at home until the test result is known, please contact school before your child returns, and please email the result to school for our attendance records.**

If any member of your household tests positive for Covid, children **must** stay at home for the period notified to you by contact tracers.

Thank you for your support with this procedure; to date the communication between school and home has been excellent. If you are in any doubt please telephone the school, we are more than happy to advise.

### SELF-ISOLATION

We have had a few queries about self-isolation. For clarity, if your child is instructed to self-isolate, this means that they must not leave the house until contact tracers have been in touch. You will then be informed how long the isolation period will last, children must not come to school until the isolation period ends.
