Monday	<p>Jolly Phonics – Recap Group 1 Sounds.</p> <p>See intro on Flipgrid:</p> <p>s a t p i n</p> <p>Adults – write the letters on cards (x2) and play snap/ matching games/hide and seek</p> <p>Ask your child to say the sound they see in different orders/different voices etc..</p> <p>Recap these activities daily.</p>	<p>Handwriting</p> <p>You have all been busy learning how to write your letters.</p> <p>It is very important that you are forming them the right way. We are going to check this by practising regularly and making sure that you are holding your pencil the right way.</p> <p>Take a look at the flipgrid video on your HWB account to follow my rules.</p> <p>Remember practise makes PERFECT!</p>	<p>Songs and Rhymes</p> <p>Each week I will be sending you a rhyme to learn at home with your family.</p> <p>This week our song will be ‘7 Days of the Week’.</p> <p>This will help with your speaking and listening skills and can be lots of fun too!</p> <p>Take a look at the flipgrid link on your HWB account.</p> <p>I would love it if you would share this with me on Flipgrid at the end of each week. (Use the ‘Record a Response’ button)</p>

Wednesday	<p>Write a list of the words you are able to make.</p>	<p>Language</p> <p>We love listening to stories in class. I have chosen the traditional tale ‘The 3 Billy Goats Gruff’ to learn more about. Follow the link</p> <p>https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/to-know-that-stories-have-problems-in-them-cnkhgr?activity=video&step=1</p> <p>If you would like to share photos of your work then send a photo to my email address.</p>	<p>ICT</p> <p>Ask an adult to log into your HWB account and open J2e.</p> <p>Click on JiT.</p> <p>Click on the ‘Paint’ tab (top right) and create a picture from the story of the 3 Billy Goats Gruff.</p> <p>Remember there are different backgrounds you can choose from and animal stampers you can pick. Choose carefully. Which is the best background? Can you find the goat stamper? How many should you stamp on your picture?</p> <p>Save your picture in your files using the blue disc symbol at the top left of the page. I will be able to see this work in your file.</p>
Thursday	<p>Read the words that you have made.</p> <p>Can you say a simple sentence using the words.</p> <p>Eg. The boy sat on the chair.</p>	<p>Mathematics</p> <p>Patterns - There are patterns all around us. Can you see any patterns around your home? Maybe in your bedroom on your duvet cover or on a cushion.</p> <p>Take a look at the video clip to learn more about patterns.</p> <p>https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/recognise-describe-and-copy-colour-and-size-patterns-6cuk0t?activity=video&step=1</p>	<p>Creative</p> <p>Following on from your maths activity can you choose from:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Paints 2. Crayons/Pencils 3. Stickers 4. Sequins 5. <p>To create your own repeating colour pattern on a long strip of paper (ask an adult to stick pieces of paper together or maybe open out a cereal box).</p> <p>You could do this more than once to create different patterns. Maybe you could challenge yourself to use 3 colours!</p> <p>Send me a photograph on HWB to show me how you got on.</p>

Friday	<p>Ask an adult to record a short video of you sharing your words and if you're feeling clever, your sentences! This could be sent to me on flipgrid that I sent on Monday for me to see all the hard work you have done with your phonics this week!!</p>	<p>Language</p> <p>Now let's take another look at the story of 'The 3 Billy Goats Gruff'.</p> <p>https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/to-sing-and-map-the-story-6xgkar?activity=video&step=1&view=1</p> <p>Have a try at drawing your own story map. Don't worry if you can't draw a goat very well, remember its important to 'have a go'.</p> <p>I'd love to see a photo of your story maps. If not keep them safe and bring them to school when we return.</p>	<p>Physical</p> <p>Do you have a set of blocks/lego at home?</p> <p>Can you build a bridge for the 3 Billy Goats Gruff to cross over?</p> <p>Or how about a castle for your Dragon to live in?</p> <p>Don't worry if you don't have blocks. How about building a den to hide in and look at your favourite story books. What might you need?</p> <p>HAVE FUN!!</p>
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READING – don't forget your reading words.
