



TIME WORD PROBLEMS

1. Ellie had an appointment at Dr. Herdman's office yesterday at 11:30 a.m. The doctor called her into her office right on time. She was out of there 25 minutes later. What time did Ellie leave the doctor's office?
2. Thomas stopped at 'Summer's Soup and Salad' bar for lunch. He stayed there until he had to leave to meet his friend, William, at the library. They were meeting at 1:30 p.m. The library is a 20-minute walk from Summer's. What time did Thomas have to leave the restaurant in order to get to the library right on time?
3. Maddie and Ryan are going to march in the big city parade on Saturday. They have to be at the parade an hour before it starts. The parade kicks off at 11 a.m. If it takes 25 minutes to walk to the starting point of the parade, what time will Maddie and Ryan have to leave home in order to be there right on time?
4. Isobel, the owner of Isobel's Cookie Jar, has to bake 12 large pans of chocolate chip cookies with her friend Sienna before they leave for the day. They can bake two pans of cookies at a time. Isobel knows that for perfect cookies each pan must bake for 15 minutes -- no more, no less. If they start baking at 5:45 p.m., what is the earliest they can close up shop?
5. Ollie has a busy day planned today. He will meet his friend, Bailey, at the skate park. That is a 15-minute walk from home. They will stay at the skate park for an hour where they will see Sebastian and Oliver. Then they will take a 10-minute walk over to the shops. The first thing they will do there is to grab a hot dog from Liesl's Burger Bar. If Ollie left home at 10:00 a.m., what time did he and Bailey get in line for a hot dog?

- C. On Wednesday, Luke, Ellis, Jacob and Vito arrived for P.E. at 2.12 p.m. Mr Walker wants everyone to be changed in 10 minutes. At what time should the children be ready to go outside?
- D. It takes Mrs Bassett 18 minutes to drive to school. If she leaves home at 7.40 a.m. at what time will she arrive?
- E. Last Wednesday, the road was flooded and Mrs Bassett was delayed by 10 minutes. If she left home at 7.45 a.m. when did she reach school?
- F. Mrs Mellor runs the after school club with Surya and Gethin from 3.15p.m. until 6.p.m.. How long is the club open each day?
- G. It takes 10 minutes to drive to Neath. Mrs Broad left school at 1.15p.m. and drove to Neath. She spent 35 minutes shopping and then drove straight back. At what time did Mrs Broad get back to school?
